

**IRON MOUNTAIN HORSE CAMP  
GENERAL RULES**

- 1. Halters must be removed from all horse while horses are in stalls**
- 2. COGGINS IS REQUIRED**
- 3. Barn lights are to be turned off at night**
- 4. No hay, feed, tack or other horse related materials are to be stacked in the barn isles.**
- 5. No horseback riding in the barn**
- 6. Do not wash horses at camp sites**
- 7. Turn off any and all water hoses located at end of barns after usage.**
- 8. When departing from your stay at IMHC you are required to remove shavings, hay, and manure from each stall and place into manure pits and or spreader.**
- 9. Failure to clean stalls will result in a \$20.00 fee, per stall, being added to your credit card and/or your bill. (If paying by cash a refundable deposit of \$20.00 per stall will be required). This rule also stands for yearly tenants.**
- 10. Use of IMHC Paddocks**
  - a. Paddocks are for the use of IMHC campers only**
  - b. There is a one (1) hour limit on the use of paddocks by any camper**
  - c. Animals in paddocks must be supervised at all time and may never be left overnight**
  - d. Paddocks, like stalls, must be picked and or cleaned after use**

**Paddocks may not be used during inclement weather and may be closed at any time at the discretion of management.**
- 11. Use of Alcohol**

**Alcohol use is allowed at campsites discretely, the management reserves the right to restrict the use of alcohol and at their sole discretion to ask anyone to leave property without refund for improper behavior.**
- 12. Quiet Time is from the hours of 10:30PM to 7:00AM**
- 13. Do not tie horses to trees, fences or corrals (use hitching rails or in stalls for any length of time) saddling and unsaddling can be done at trailers. Do not tie to decks or porches.**
- 14. Dogs are welcome but must be kelp at their camp sites unless with owners under control (must have rabies shots).**
