

IRON MOUNTAIN HORSE CAMP GENERAL RULES

1. Halters must be removed from all equine while equine is in stalls
2. COGGINS are REQUIRED and proof of Rabies vaccinations for dogs
3. Barn lights are to be turned off at night
4. No hay, feed, tack or other horse related materials are to be stacked in the barn aisles. Please use designated area in the barn
5. No riding of equine in the barn
6. Do not wash horses at campsites or in the aisle of the barn.
7. Turn off any and all water hoses located at end of barns after usage
8. When departing from your stay at IMHC you are required to remove shavings, hay, and manure from each stall and place into manure pits and or spreader.
9. Stalls must be stripped cleaned at the end of your stay. The campground offers stall stripping for a \$10 fee.
10. Quiet Time is from the hours of 10:30PM to 7:30AM
11. Smoking is **not** allowed in any campground building including barns, bathhouse, hay barn, and tack office
12. Pet friendly, dogs are welcome, but **must** be on a leash in the campground
13. **No aggressive dogs.** Pit-bulls and rottweilers are not permitted on the premises due to insurance requirements.
14. Please do not leave your pets outside at night
15. Children 10 and under in age **must** be attended by an adult in the barns. Children 16 and under are **not allowed** to drive ATVs, golf carts, or any motorized vehicles on premises
13. Do not tie horses to trees, fences or corrals (use hitching rails). Saddling and unsaddling can be done at trailers. Do not tie to decks or porches.
14. No Stallions allowed on the premises due to insurance requirements.
